



Vote **GREEN** for a *real* change on 5th May

Tomorrow you will have the opportunity to cast **TWO** votes in the Waveney District Council election. As we've knocked on doors over the last few weeks (sorry if we haven't managed to catch you in) it has become increasingly clear that **Kate Jackson** and **Josiah Meldrum** have a very real chance of winning both Bungay seats. We'd like to take this last opportunity to let you know what a Green win in Bungay would mean and ask you to use **both your votes** to make a real difference and elect Kate and Josiah.

If elected tomorrow Kate and Josiah will:

- ✓ **Put Bungay people first:** Kate and Josiah are not interested in party politics and will be working for Bungay first, Waveney second and the Green Party third.
- ✓ **Defend open spaces in Bungay:** Open spaces are at a premium in Bungay, Kate and Josiah will work to ensure they are not lost to the community, are properly maintained and are connected to the rest of the town by safe cycling and walking routes.
- ✓ **Work to improve neighbourhood play areas:** Safe outdoor play is an essential part of every child's development. Bungay is blessed with a number of neighbourhood play areas but most are in need of improved facilities and care: Kate and Josiah will push for these improvements to be made.
- ✓ **Tackle Bungay's traffic problems:** Kate and Josiah will work with local residents to develop workable and affordable ideas to reduce Bungay's traffic problems - to start with they will promote walking and cycling, argue for the enforcement of current traffic and parking regulations and the introduction of a 20 mile an hour speed limit through the town centre.
- ✓ **Hold regular District Councillor surgeries:** Kate and Josiah will be working for you and will make sure that, as well as being reachable in all the usual ways, there will be regular public surgeries - perhaps promoted and run in conjunction with the Town Council's existing surgeries.
- ✓ **Press the District Council to ensure ALL its properties are well insulated and that many generate some of their own energy:** Poorly insulated public buildings and tenanted council properties are unnecessarily expensive to run, in addition many of these properties could generate some of their own electricity or heat (and a small income) through solar panels or air source heat pumps.
- ✓ **Continue to fight for vital public services like the library:** Kate and Josiah will use their position on Waveney District Council to fight to protect services administered by the District and to lobby Suffolk County Council to do the same.



Argue for more and better recycling facilities in Bungay: As well as working with local waste management experts to develop a business case for a "Community Reuse and Recycling Centre" at the Beccles Household Waste Site, Kate and Josiah aim to improve the current recycling facilities in Bungay by widening the range of materials collected and supporting events like Sustainable Bungay's Give and Take Days.



Encourage Waveney District Council to think more creatively about municipal gardens and grassed areas: There are lots of odd (small) corners of land around the town, many are maintained at some cost by Waveney District Council but could be planted much more creatively and managed much more efficiently. For example many housing associations now hand these 'dead spaces' to local residents who grow food and run gardening clubs.



Work with Bungay Town Council to get the best for Bungay: Kate and Josiah will make a report at every Town Council meeting and take concerns and ideas raised by the Town Council back to Waveney District Council.
