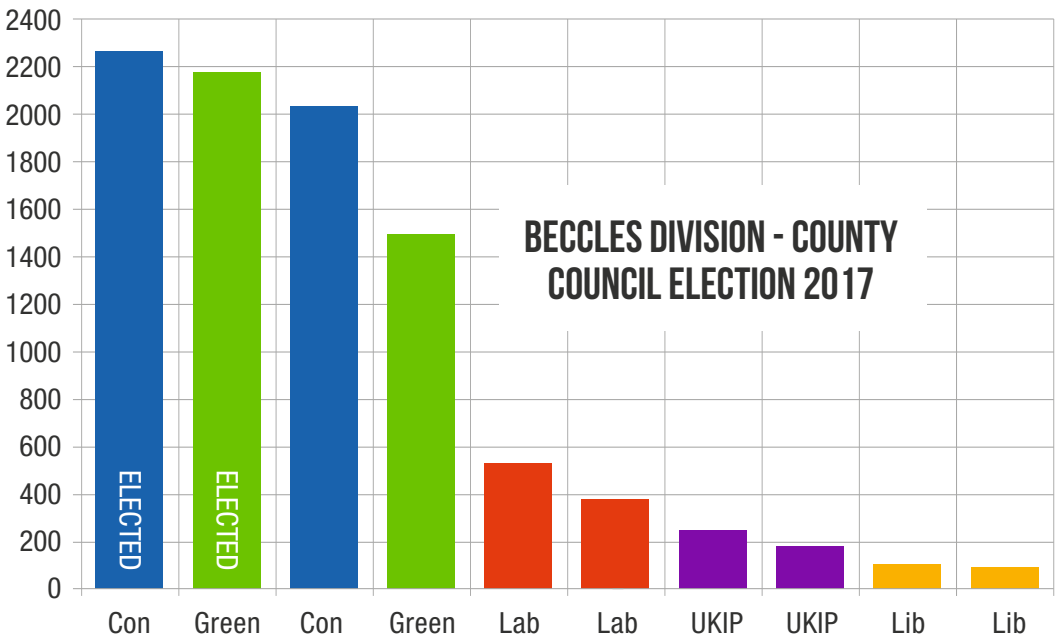


IT'S GREEN OR BLUE HERE!

OUR COMMITMENTS TO YOU

If elected Elfrede, Graham and Caroline would

- Fight to keep and improve local services which continue to be threatened by government cuts and privatisation. Seek to bring outsourced Council services back under direct Council control.
- Continue to fight for weight limits on roads in Beccles and Worlingham to ensure our communities benefit from the new relief road.
- Fight for safety improvements to the A146 junctions at North Cove and Barnby.
- Continue to work towards creating an attractive railway station forecourt with adequate station parking.
- Promote waste reduction and recycling initiatives and pilot a “Zero Waste” demonstration within the ward.
- Protect our green spaces and allotments and set up a community orchard project.
- Set up a monthly Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) support group for parents in the area.
- Ensure speculative housing development is prevented. Central government rules mean that if our Local Plan is deemed “out of date” the National Planning Policy Framework will apply and this would allow a virtual “free for all” for developers.
- Fight for the provision of genuinely affordable housing in developments and ensure that housing is built to the highest possible energy standards.
- Ensure the pedestrian and cycle path alongside the new relief road is extended to the businesses on the Ellough Industrial estates.
- Continue to support local sports clubs, youth groups, Beccles Lido, Beccles Public Hall, Beccles Bombs and other community groups.
- Tackle dog mess and litter which continue to spoil many streets and open spaces. Set up a community based Bomble organisation in Barnby, North Cove and Worlingham to help remove litter from our public spaces.

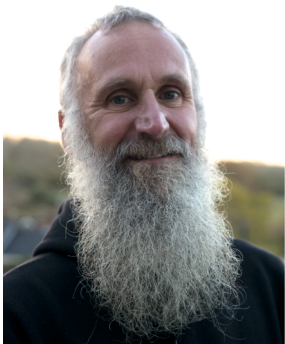


ABOUT US



ELFREDE BRAMBLEY-CRAWSHAW

Elfrede has been a County Councillor for the last 2 years and has spent the last year as Mayor of Beccles. Elfrede is keen to develop community spaces for everyone to enjoy and has worked hard to improve the town’s playparks. She established Beccles Community gardeners, has successfully chaired Beccles Neighbourhood Plan, has been instrumental in setting up the new youth cafe and is an active Library trustee. She is keen to plan events that bring the community together, which this year included the Remembrance Sunday lantern parade, relief road cycle event and the 100 years of Suffrage event.



GRAHAM ELLIOTT

Graham has been a District Councillor for 12 years and a Town Councillor for the last 4 years.
